Economic study finds Tulane University is the city's largest private employer

Tulane University is the city's largest private employer and a major economic driver in the region, according to a new study by Appleseed, a New York-based economic development firm.

The study shows that Tulane accounts for approximately \$920 million in annual economic activity and is responsible for 10,600 direct and indirect Louisiana jobs.

The study examines Tulane's economic impact in a variety of ways, including employment, student spending, the \$9.9 million in annual state income taxes its payroll generates and the more than \$9 million in fees it pays each year to state and local governments.
